Alvin Wallace was the feature demonstrator at the July monthly meeting. Alvin brought a pre-glued, segmented

“sandwich” bowl to show the members the difficulty in turning a bowl where you have two different densities of wood. Making the transition from



softer wood to harder wood is difficult as is the transition going back from the hardwood to softwood. Alvin demonstrated the use of a bowl gouge to make a shearing cut on the outside of the bowl and used a scraper for the final cuts on the inside of the bowl.
